<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Covering the head to show respect for Allah Use Story Sack 	<p>Look at the Muslim headscarf and cap in the Story Sack</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about the shape and the colour of the head coverings Look at the pictures of Tayeba wearing her scarf: book cover and pages 6, 11, 16, 19, 21 Read page 11 which explains why Tayeba and her brother cover their heads
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allah the Creator Use My Muslim Faith 	<p>Look at/read pages 7, 8, 9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about the natural world, the trees, plants, sky Discuss how humans can care for the natural world Draw pictures of the natural world Look at/read page 19 Discuss ways people can be kind to others and share what they have
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Worshipping Allah/thanking Allah for good things through prayer 	<p>Look at pages 10, 11, 12, 13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss how Tayeba prepares to pray by washing and covering the head Talk about when and how Tayeba prays: pages 12, 13: notice how the family kneel on their prayer mats Look at a prayer mat, discuss the designs Draw or make a large prayer mat on sugar paper to display in the classroom
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Special places, books and times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss the mosque and Ka'bah (pages 20, 21, 14); Qur'an (pages 15, 16, 17); Ramadan (pages 22, 23) and Id (pages 25, 26, 27, 28)
